

## Evaluation of Presentation

### Style:

- Pace: just right, too fast, too slow
- Clarity of oral presentation: good, marginal, not clear
- Clarity of written presentation (slides): good, marginal, not clear
- Enthusiasm: good, marginal, not enough
- Self-confidence of the speaker: good, marginal, not enough

### Content:

- Level of presentation: just right, too high, too low
- Amount of material: just right, too much, too little
- Organization of material: good, marginal, not sufficiently organized
- Level of knowledge of the speaker about the topic: good, marginal, not sufficient
- Level of interest of the chosen topic: good, marginal, not sufficiently interesting
- References: just right, too many, too few

### Responses to questions from audience:

- good, marginal, needs improvement

### Title/Abstract:

- Clarity: good, marginal, not clear
- Adequately reflect content: yes, no

### Overall evaluation of the presentation:

- Great talk - let's have another!
- Good talk - could use some improvement
- Hmm... needs considerable improvement
